This combination ensures interdisciplinary approach to training.</p> <p>Theoretical courses and practical training are focused on in-depth analysis of modern civil and corporate law problems, as well as the foundations of Russian civil reality. Apart from acquiring knowledge and research skills Master students have their practical training and gain some experience of teaching legal disciplines, master on-line teaching methods and effective methods of teaching law. This will enable students to start a teacher's career and hold workshops and trainings on corporate law issues in the future.</p>
